

COVID-19 Safe Plan for Canberra Community Chorale

This Covid-19 Safe Plan applies to rehearsals in Cook Hall (which can accommodate > 100 people if a “1 person per 2 square metre rule” is applicable, although that rule is currently not applicable).

All persons attending are required to be up to date with their Covid-19 vaccination and to provide proof of this to the committee secretary (Jean) before attending rehearsals.

The committee needs to know who attends each rehearsal, so that we can contact you if someone at the rehearsal is later diagnosed as having Covid-19. Please make your attendance known to the roll keeper at rehearsal each week.

Please DO NOT come to a rehearsal if you feel unwell or have cold or flu-like symptoms.

If you attend a rehearsal and are subsequently diagnosed with Covid-19 you MUST notify the secretary immediately.

Masks need only be worn if ACT restrictions require (not currently required) but members are welcome to wear masks if they wish to.

Chairs for rehearsal will be sanitised and set up before and after each rehearsal by some volunteers and/or the hall cleaner. Chairs will be more widely spaced than at a pre-Covid choir rehearsal (to ensure that attendees remain as safe as possible) although there are currently no restrictions in effect with respect to the spacing of chairs nor any current “persons per square metre” rules in effect.

When you arrive at rehearsal you may wish to Check in with the CheckIn CBR app, although this is no longer mandatory and check in signs may not be available any more.

Please clean your hands with the hand sanitiser that will be located near the entry door.

It is recommended that you do not share scores or pencils.

Do not touch the keyboard at any time – this is for Lucus alone to use.

Other things you need to know:-

- Rehearsals will run from 12:30 pm until 2:30 pm including a break.
- The windows and doors on both sides of the hall will be open as much as is practical to allow for good ventilation, so please make sure that you dress warmly.
- The hall toilets will be available for use.
- If ACT restrictions require, rehearsals may be cancelled at short notice, so please check your email each week.

Please remember to maintain social distancing at all times, even when you are chatting with your fellow choristers during the break and before or after the rehearsal.
